The RAOU was founded in 1901 by a group of amateurs interested in the scientific study of birds. In the 90 years since then, the RAOU has provided a focus for researchers, both amateur and professional, working to increase our knowledge of the birds of Australasia. By the scientific study of the birds of our region, the RAOU promotes conservation through knowledge. Scientific data are essential to making informed decisions about our avifauna. To this end, the RAOU coordinates the national Nest Record Scheme, the Australian Bird Count and study programmes of threatened and endangered birds. The RAOU is consulted regularly by government organizations, companies, educational institutions and interested individuals. The Handbook of Australian, New Zealand and Antarctic Birds provides an authoritative basis for making decisions about our avifauna and for the directions of future research.

The RAOU publishes *Emu*, a quarterly scientific journal and Australia's only internationally recognized ornithological journal. The Union also publishes a quarterly magazine for all members, *RAOU Conservation Statements*, the *RAOU Report* series and *RAOU Monographs*. HANZAB continues the RAOU's achievements in publishing: *The Atlas of Australian Birds* and *Shorebirds in Australia* and the recently published *Threatened and Extinct Birds of Australia*.
